### Southwest Marine to be Staging Area for Channel Dredging – Closes To Filming

Wharfingers remain available for Port of LA film locations  
CRA makes warehouses available

---

The Southwest Marine facility will close to filming on September 1, 2010 as it becomes a staging area for a major channel dredging project. The buildings will not be demolished. The entire property at Southwest Marine will be a repository for wood and concrete demolished in other areas of the Port, making the site unsafe and unsuitable for filming activity.

The Wharfinger's Office remains available to take calls for Port of LA facilities for filming at 310.732.3810 during business hours (Mon – Thurs 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.; Fri 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.).

Large warehouse facilities similar to Southwest Marine, although not waterfront, may be available through the City of Los Angeles' Redevelopment Agency. Please contact FilmL.A.'s Production Planning Team at 213.977.8600 for assistance.

The Port of LA will issue a notice through FilmL.A. when the project is complete and the Southwest Marine site is available for filming.
