

SPECIAL FILMING CONDITIONS 5400 BLOCK OF WILBUR AVENUE

The Special Filming Conditions described below will be included in the terms and conditions of permits issued for filming in this area and are in addition to the standard terms and conditions applicable to filming permits generally. While these Special Filming Conditions will be included as terms if a permit for filming in this area is issued, they are not intended to, and do not, establish the criteria or standards for determining whether or not a particular permit (or permits) will be issued for this area. The decision whether or not a particular permit (or permits) will be issued is vested in the discretion of the appropriate City or County department or their designees (including FilmL.A., Inc.), to be exercised consistent with public health, safety and general welfare, and applicable land-use ordinances.

The 5400 block of Wilbur Avenue is a quiet, charming residential area without sidewalks, that has been used over the past several years for location filming. The following conditions have been established to mitigate the concerns of local residents and to provide for a balanced use of the street and filming property.

- **Affected residents must be notified at least two (2) days in advance of the first filming day or the first day of any substantial set preparation.** *Permit requests must be submitted at least three (3) days in advance.*
- **Equipment parking and associated posting on Wilbur Avenue should be kept to a minimum for essential vehicles only.** *Driveways may not be used as turnarounds.*
- **An LAPD officer required when parking on Wilbur Avenue during weekdays while school is in session.**
- **Additional area for posting** is the East side of Topeka Drive, 150' on either side of 5520 Topeka Drive (directly in front of the church and only where the street is markedly wider). Overflow equipment vehicles may not be parked on Crebs Avenue at any time.
- **Parking is not allowed in front of 5443 Wilbur Avenue.**
- **Cast and crew personal vehicles are not permitted to park on area streets.** Off-street parking must be provided for production company vehicles.
- **Production companies may not arrive in the area prior to 7:00 a.m. and must depart no later than 10:00 p.m.** unless approval is obtained from the Permit Authority and the approved times are indicated on the permit.
- **Weekend filming is prohibited** unless approved by the Permit Authority.
- **Property boundaries on Wilbur Avenue can be difficult to determine.** Extra care should be given to obtaining owner permission for all proposed activities.
- **Activities may not interfere with scheduled trash collection (Thursday).**
- **Craft services, catering trucks, food preparation tables and dining tables are prohibited on all neighborhood grass areas (including Crebs Avenue) and must be out of public view.**
- **A FilmL.A. Monitor will be assigned to encourage compliance with the permit and conditions.**
The Monitor will generally arrive at the designated location 1 hour prior to the permit start time to note proper arrival time and remain with the production company during all filming-related activities and ensure proper departure time.
