

SPECIAL FILMING CONDITIONS

100, 200, 300 & 400 BLOCKS OF NORTH CARMELINA AVENUE

The Special Filming Conditions described below will be included in the terms and conditions of permits issued for filming in this area and are in addition to the standard terms and conditions applicable to filming permits generally. While these Special Filming Conditions will be included as terms if a permit for filming in this area is issued, they are not intended to, and do not, establish the criteria or standards for determining whether or not a particular permit (or permits) will be issued for this area. The decision whether or not a particular permit (or permits) will be issued is vested in the discretion of the appropriate City or County department or their designees (including FilmLA), to be exercised consistent with public health, safety and general welfare, and applicable land-use ordinances.

- **Affected residents must be notified at least two (2) days in advance of the first day of filming or the first day of any substantial set preparation.** Affected residences are considered to be the three (3) adjoining properties on each side; property to the rear and adjoining property on each side; property across the street and three (3) adjoining properties to each side. For corner locations, each other corner shall be considered “a property across the street”. *Permit requests must be submitted to FilmLA at least three (3) days in advance.*
- **Filming on Saturdays, Sundays or major holidays is generally prohibited** unless approved by the Permit Authority.
- **Arrival prior to 7 a.m. or departure later than 10 p.m. is strictly prohibited** unless approval is obtained from the Permit Authority and the approved times are indicated on the permit.
- **Cast and crew may not park on area streets.** Companies should obtain parking for personal vehicles at nearby lots and shuttle to the location.
- **Equipment must be parked on one side of the street only and must be arranged so as to not block driveways.** Every effort should be made to get as much equipment as possible off the street.
- **All production vehicles shall be identified by an 8½ x 11 inch card or sign placed on the windshield or vehicle front.** Identification plates shall state in large letters: permittee’s name and telephone number of the person authorized to resolve complaints and the telephone number of FilmLA.
- **Generators shall be shielded to minimize noise.** All generators shall be located on the property for which the permit is issued.
- **Bullhorns may not be used.**
- **Preparation, service and eating of meals shall be on private property,** out of public view and not in the public right-of-way.
- **The production area shall be cleaned daily.**
- **A FilmLA Monitor will be assigned to encourage compliance with the permit and conditions.** The Monitor will generally arrive at the designated location 1 hour prior to the permit start time to note proper arrival time and remain with the production company during all filming related activities and to ensure proper departure time.
